



2021-2022 FARM BUREAU YOUTH AMBASSADOR APPLICATION FORM

ELIGIBILITY

The Delaware Farm Bureau Women's Committee will be accepting applications for the Youth Ambassador Program to represent the Delaware Farm Bureau throughout the year at various events. There will be one person chosen from each county to represent their respective County. Each County Ambassador will then have a chance to be chosen as the State Ambassador.

To be eligible, applicant must:

- Be the son or daughter of a Delaware Farm Bureau member
- have an active membership for more than one year with dues paid
- be an incoming high school junior or senior at the time of application

RULES & REQUIREMENTS

- All applications must be typed.
- Applicants must be prepared to give oral presentation the day of judging
- Students must submit a head and shoulders portrait of themselves.
- All application materials are due in the State Office by 4 p.m. on **June 25, 2021. If you mail to the address below, the application must be received by the State Office no later than 4 p.m. on June 25, 2021.**

The winner of the State Ambassador will receive a \$1000.00 scholarship provided the following criteria is achieved. To qualify, the State Ambassador must earn 20 points during their one-year reign of August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022. Those points may be earned by attending a combination of the following events:

- Attend an Annual County Meeting/Banquet—5 pts.
- Attend the Farm Bureau Annual Banquet in December—5 pts.
- Attend Ag Industry Dinner in January—5 pts.
- Attend one Young Farmers and Ranchers Committee event- 5 pts.
- Attend one Women's Committee event- 5 pts.
- Attend one Promotion and Education Committee event- 5 pts.
- Attend one Delaware Farm Bureau Foundation Event- 5 pts.
- Volunteer a total of 8 hours at the Delaware Farm Bureau Food booth/Commodities building during the State Fair- 5pts.
(does not include working for a 4H or FFA group)

Once points have been earned and verified by the Women’s Committee, and upon completion of the first semester of college, please send to the state office a copy of your final grades for the first semester and proof of enrollment for the second semester. Please include your student ID number and the name and address of the college you are attending.

THE STATE WINNER WILL BE AWARDED

- A \$1,000 scholarship to be paid directly to their college or university
- A long sleeve dress shirt and a short sleeve polo shirt with the Delaware Farm Bureau logo to be worn during Farm Bureau functions.
- A \$100 check upon completion of their year during the following year’s State Farm Bureau Banquet

COUNTY WINNERS WILL BE AWARDED

- A long sleeve dress shirt and a short sleeve polo shirt to be worn during Farm Bureau functions.
- The two county winners not chosen as the State Youth Ambassador will receive \$100 at the Delaware Farm Bureau Annual Banquet
- *County winners may also be asked to make an oral presentation of their essay at their county’s fall banquet*
